<p>Our History curriculum aims to develop historical skills and concepts which are transferable to whatever period of history is being studied and will equip children for future learning. IMPLEMENTATION	
<p>Due to the size of the school, there is a two-year rolling program (Year 1 & Year 2, Lower Key Stage 2 and Upper Key Stage 2) In order for children to know more and remember more in each area of history studied, there is a structure to the lesson sequence whereby prior learning is always considered and opportunities for revision of facts and historical understanding are built into lessons. The revision and introduction of key vocabulary is built into each lesson. This vocabulary is then included in display materials and additional resources to ensure that children are allowed opportunities to repeat and revise this knowledge. Adult guides and accurate historical subject knowledge are always provided within lessons to allow the teacher and adults working in those lessons to feel confident and supported with the historical skills and knowledge that they are teaching. Through lessons, we intend to inspire pupils and practitioners to develop a love of history and see how it has shaped the world they live in.</p>
