Subject: Music

TNTFNT

Music should be an enjoyable experience for all participants. Children should be able to participate in a range of musical experiences which contribute to building their confidence. They will develop their understanding of rhythm and pitch and learn how music is structured, as well as learning technical vocabulary. As their confidence builds, so will their enjoyment of the performance aspect of music. Children will also have the opportunity to listen to music from different cultures and eras.

TMPI FMFNTATION

Music is taught as a discrete subject by one teacher across Key Stage I and Key Stage 2 ensuring consistency and progression. Singing assemblies allow children the opportunities to develop their singing skills and gain an understanding of how ensembles work. Special occasions such as Harvest Festival, Christmas, Plays and Performances, Easter and End of Year demonstrate that music is important to the life of the school.
